

The Student Satisfaction Survey Report 2021-22

According to the guidelines of NAAC Students Satisfaction Survey was conducted in this academic year. The questioner was also framed as per the guidelines of NAAC. And the questioner was distributed to students by internet and the same was also available on the college website. Students responded to the said questioner on the Google form. The data is collected through Google Form only.

The first five questions were formal questions and were related to the student's academic information and authentication of the responding student. The second part of the said questioner is a feedback about the institution and teaching learning process in the institution.

In this second part of the questioner first question was,

How much syllabus covered in the class? It is observed that ninety five per cent students responded that, at least seventy to hundred per cent syllabus is covered in the class. It must be noted that, this semester was also affected by Covid-19 pandemic and the teaching learning process was through online medium. Yet ninety five per cent students responded positively.

Second question was, how well did the teachers was prepared for the classes? Ninety Seven point Nine per cent students responded positively and that the teachers were prepared satisfactorily or thoroughly. For the remaining two per cent, continues efforts are made to improve teaching methods.

Next question was, how well the teachers were able to communicate? Ninety per cent students said always effective or sometime effective teachers suitably communicate with the students. In this area we are improving and trying to adopt on line mode of teaching.

Next question was, the teacher approach to the teaching can be best described as, 1. Excellent 2. Very Good 3. Good 4. Fair 5. Poor. It was seen that, ninety six per cent students responded positively and said that, the teacher's approach to the teaching can be best described as either Good, Very Good or Excellent.

Next question is about the fairness in the internal evaluation process. It was noticed that, Ninety two per cent students responded positively. Ninety two per cent students opted for the Usually Fair or Always Fair options.

Next question is also about fairness in the internal evaluation process. And it is recorded that, eighty three per cent students responded that their assessment is discussed with them. We are committed to the fairness in the evaluation process, and in upcoming internal exams, performance of students will be discussed with them.

Next question is, the institution takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for the students? It must be noted that in this phase of Covid 19 and restriction still ninety two per cent students responded positively to the promotion of internship and field visits.

Next question is about the mentorship available in the college. Eighty per cent students responded positively to the teaching and mentoring process facilitates in the development of students. In the upcoming years mentorship system will be developed.

The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. Eighty five per cent students agreed that, the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

Next question was, Teachers informs you about the expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. Eighty five per cent students positively responded that, teachers informs about the expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

Next question was, your mentor do necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. It was found that, eighty five per cent students responded positively and recorded that, mentor do necessary follow-up with assigned task.

Next question was, teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications. It was found that, ninety three per cent students positively and said that teachers illustrate the concept through examples and applications.

In the next question it is found that, eighty three per cent students responded that, teachers identifies strengths and provides right level of challenges to them.

In the next question it is found that, seventy eight per cent students responded that, teachers are able identifies weakness and help them to overcome the problems.

In the next question eighty four per cent students agreed that, the institution makes efforts to encourage the students in mentoring, review and continues quality improvement of teaching learning process.

About the student centric method, eighty two per cent students agreed that the institution / teachers use experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodology.


In the next question, eighty six per cent students agreed that, the teachers encourages students to participate in extra-curricular activities.

Eighty two per cent students agreed that, efforts are made by the teachers, institution inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills.

Seventy five per cent students recorded that, at least fifty percent of teachers used ICT tools.

Eighty eight per cent of the students agreed that, the quality of the teaching learning process of institution is very good.




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
