April, 2023-

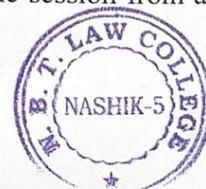

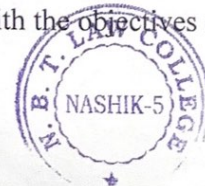
January, 2024-

Unit for thew camp comprised of 50 Volunteers and actively participated in the daily activities scheduled. Day 1- 31st January, 2024

The other Members of Village Panchayat, Shri Bhadane Sir, Principal, ZP High School, Shri Shewale Sir, Principal, Govt Madhyaamik Ashram Shala, Pimpalgaon(G), Registrar, Shri Tambe Sir, Coordinator Shrimati Smita Tejale, Sub-Centre Primary Health Care, and village residents were also present for the inaugural function. The Principal, Vice Principal and NSS PO welcomed all the guests and felicitated them by giving Plant and also guided all with the objectives of



NSS Special Winter Camp. Dty. Sarpanch Mr. Akash Tidme welcomed all volunteers and discussed the present condition of the village and their expectations from the volunteers to assist in solving the common issues during the NSS camp. Chief Guest Shri Ashok Sonawane Sir has guided all present guests, members of the village panchayat and volunteers on how to execute camp activities successfully. He advised them to focus on plantation activities and rainwater harvesting techniques and declared that the NSS Special Winter Camp was inaugurated. NSS Assistant Programme Officer Dr. Sandip Satbhai proposed a vote of thanks.

Day 2- 01st February, 2024

All the volunteers started working as per the instructions of Shri Bhadane Sir. The ZP School Campus was having waste of building materials and bushes, and weeds around the wall compound of the school. All stones were collected at two locations, and unwanted grass was removed and collected at different places to dispose of the same. The village survey was also a part of the planned activity of day two. All volunteers gathered and decided on important questions to be asked.

To collect data regarding the following things random questionnaire was prepared on the following points.

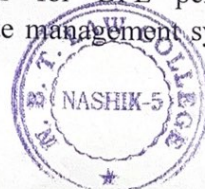
1. Size of the Family (From a Population Control point of view)
2. Government Schemes (Linking Mobile no to Aadhaar)
3. Girl Child Education
4. Status of Women
5. Waste Management
6. Health Facilities (Ayushyman Card)
7. Legal Awareness
8. Sanitation, etc.

After interactions with all villagers on the above-mentioned points it is observed that few families are big size family due to wanting a male child, many villagers are unaware of government schemes available for them, mobile no and Aadhaar linking are not done to avail benefits of various schemes, health facilities are inadequate to fulfil the emergency needs like pregnancy related issues, facility for delivery etc. It was discussed and decided to submit the information to Village Panchayat for further action. The special guidance lecture on "Participation in Democracy and Voter Awareness" was organised by Dr Medha Saykhedkar.

In the evening remaining cleanliness work was continued by all the volunteers.

Day 3- 02nd February, 2024

All campers discussed many things like there is a need to create awareness on cleanliness, waste management, various health schemes for BPL persons, Ayushyman Bharat Yojana etc. It is observed that the waste management system



was lacking due to which plastic waste is dumped on the outskirts of village roads. As decided earlier the volunteers started digging the dry waste disposal pit for all dry waste material generated from the kitchen of the school and campus. Three volunteers started the waste management pit and all others reached the main entrance road of the village, Garudeshwar Temple, Hanuman Temple and near the village panchayat office. The weeds beside the roads were removed and the roads were cleaned by sweeping. The plant's preservation is done and beautified by using bricks and removing all plastic waste. The building material levelling was done near the water tank. The village panchayat office and nearby roads were also cleaned by removing weeds and sweeping.

In the second half a guest lecture was organised on "Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj & Youth" by Shivshri Samadhan Hengade Patil. He has guided all present members on various skills of King Shivaji which are useful to today's youth. History is important to become a successful one, he stated. All schoolchildren and villagers were present for the lecture.

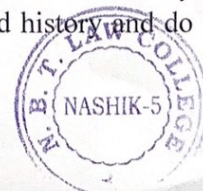
Day 4- 03rd February, 2024

The pre-planned activities are a cleanliness campaign in the Primary Health Centre, Sabha Mandap & Devi Mandir. According to the plan, all volunteers reached the School campus and prepared various slogans on Population Control, plantation, cleanliness, health, safety, girl child education and voting awareness. The rally started along with all ZP School teachers and students. The rally got a positive response from all villagers.

The guest lecture on the topic "Organ Donation is Life Donation" by Dr Shalini Ghumare. She has created awareness of various aspects of organ donation and compliance to be done before donating any organ. Information related to the government schemes and various documents which are required before donation was discussed.

Day 5- 04th February, 2024

Before breakfast, all performed NSS Geet and prayers and also physical training given by Tejraj Dongade to all volunteers and school children. The planned activities include removing unwanted stones and bricks near the kitchen shed and beautification of the school campus. All volunteers were divided into two groups and started work. The boys completed the task given as per the instructions of the ZP Head Master and removed waste building material from the entry gate of the school. The remaining volunteers and most of the female volunteers beautified the campus and decorated almost all trees and plants on the campus with ochre & quick lime. The lecture on the topic "Shivaji Maharaj and Nashik " was delivered by Shivshri Gaurav Gajare. He has stated that every youth should read history and do



something for the conservation of forts near Nashik city. He stated that Nashik was a significant place in deciding war strategies against the Mughals. Nashik is one of the best heritage cities in India. The battle of Surat was explained in detail and all myths were removed from the minds of the present audience.

Day 6- 05th February, 2024

All volunteers observed Ashram Shala students for at least 4 days and decided to do certain activities for their upbringing and to give exposure to their skills and motivate them to a successful person. Accordingly, volunteers were given instructions and divided into groups of 3 volunteers each and assigned planned activities like Health and Personal Hygiene, Essay Competition, Singing Competition, Elocution Competition, Drawing Competition, Guidance to 7th to 8th standard students like significance of sports activities in shaping their career, 9th std and 10th std students were guided on opportunities available in various streams like Arts, Commerce, Science, Engineering, Vocational education etc. and also to study competitive examinations of MPSC.

In the second half, Adv Dilpal Singh Rana delivered a lecture on "Cyber Security Awareness" to all volunteers Students of Government Madhyamik Ashram Shala and all teaching staff. He has discussed various aspects of privacy and cybercrime due to the use of technology in day-to-day activities.

Youth are facing many issues and committing suicide as they are not mentally fit to solve the stress-related issues therefore regular meditation and exercise are important, he added.

The venue for the valedictory function was finalised and decided to organise in Ashram Shala Multi-Purpose Hall at 03:00 pm. The Chief Guest of the function Dr. V. N. Suryawanshi Sir Arrived at 03:00 pm along with Dr. H. A. Kadri Principal In charge of the college. The Principal Mr Shewale Sir, the Chairperson, the School Management Committee, Ms. Vyavhare Madam, Rector Ramteke Madam, and the Principal of ZP School were present for the programme.


Awareness Program on Cyber Security and Digital Safety=
