- **Purpose** of the research. Solve personal problems but more concerned about social problems and then again more concerned about the legal problems.
- Also, all the components of the research i. e., preliminary requirements such cover page or title page, table of contents, publications, list of tables or figures or diagrams, abstract, list of abbreviations, declarations or statement of authorship, acknowledgement, etc.
- Then about Introduction, Literature Review, Sequential Chapters, Conclusions and Recommendations of future studies, References or Bibliography, Appendices.
- These each were in detailed explained by Dr Kadri Sir.
- His language is simple and understanding.
- He suggested a new topic that is impact of the new criminal law regimes in India. One can do research on this.
- Research problem should be existing one.
