ADMISSION NOTICE – LL.B. (3 Years) & B.A. LL.B. (5 Years)

ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27

As per the guidelines and directions of the CET Cell and Government of Maharashtra, the following documents are mandatory for admission. Without the required documents, admission shall not be granted.

Documents Required:

1. CET Application Form
2. CET Hall Ticket & Score Card
3. CAP Application Form, Option Form & Provisional Allotment Letter – 2 copies
4. Domicile & Nationality Certificate
5. All Mark Sheets – SSC, XI, HSC and all years/semesters of Degree, as applicable
6. Conversion Certificate in case of Grade/GPA/CGPA
7. Original Transfer Certificate (T.C.)
8. Migration Certificate, if applicable
9. Gap Certificate, if applicable
10. Caste Certificate & Caste Validity Certificate, if applicable
11. Valid Non-Creamy Layer Certificate – NT-A/B/C/D, OBC, SBC, etc., if applicable
12. EWS/SEBC Certificate, if applicable
13. Aadhaar Card & ABC ID/APAAR ID
14. One complete set of photocopies of all documents

Important Instructions:

1. The Conversion Certificate must be prepared by calculating marks of all years/semesters of the qualifying examination.
2. If there is any mismatch between the Conversion Certificate and the marks calculated by the Admission Committee, the admission shall be rejected/cancelled.
3. LL.B. (3 Years) students whose qualifying result is in CGPA/Grade must submit the University Ledger/Statement of Marks for all years/semesters.
4. Candidates having qualifications other than HSC for B.A. LL.B. or a regular three-year Degree for LL.B. must submit the required Equivalence Certificate as per rules.
5. All documents are subject to verification. No admission shall be given without the required documents.
